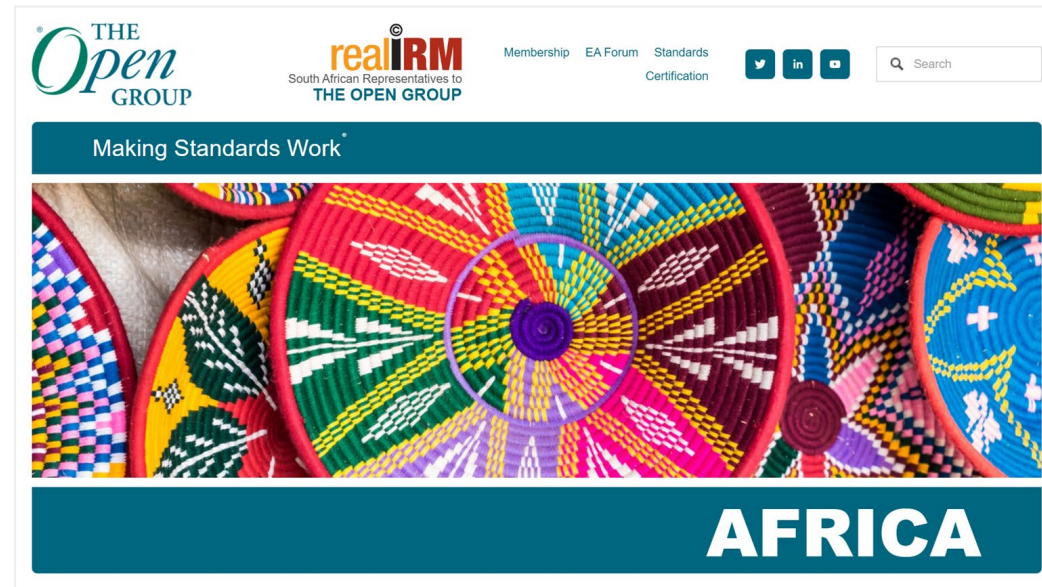


# The South African EA Forum
